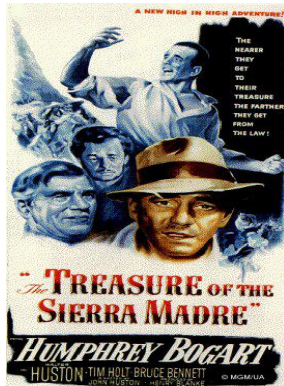

lines during World War II on a mission to recover some of the world's greatest works of art.

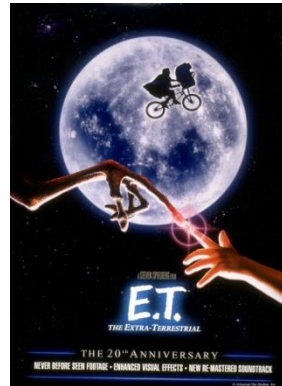

deleted scenes restored and digitally refurbished special effects.

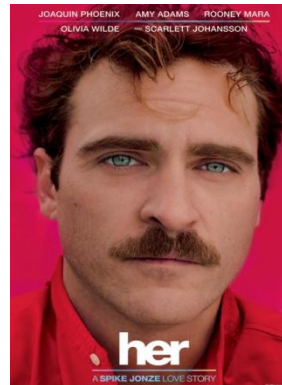
